Big cocaine bust on I-80

A Utah Highway Patrol trooper arrested two men Friday on suspicion of carrying about 320 pounds of cocaine in their vehicle. Both men are from the Bay area of California. Troopers believe they were transporting the cocaine, shown stacked on a UHP vehicle above, from California to Chicago, according to UHP spokesman Rich Christianson. A trooper pulled the car over on I-80 in Summit County for speeding. The driver agreed to the trooper's request to search the vehicle, Christianson said.
